

## **Hunter Dressage**

Exhibitors will be able to select the date they want to complete their Hunter Dressage classes at entry time. These classes are available during these two days to allow youth to select the day that is least likely to conflict with other classes. Ride times will be assigned to exhibitors just like in the past but will be on the day on which they have registered. Both sessions for each class will be combined following completion of session 2 with awards and high point award points being distributed as one class.

- Session 1 – Wednesday, June 24 from 3pm-5pm
  - 901W: Introductory Hunter Dressage – Wednesday
  - 902W: Training Hunter Dressage – Wednesday
  - 909W: First Level Hunter Dressage – Wednesday
- Session 2 – Thursday, June 25 beginning at 8am
  - 901T: Introductory Hunter Dressage – Thursday
  - 902T: Training Hunter Dressage – Thursday
  - 909T: First Level Hunter Dressage – Thursday

## **Combined Training**

Exhibitors in the Combined Training classes (460, 461, 462) will complete their Dressage test at the end of Hunter Dressage Session 2 on Thursday, June 25. This session begins at 8am. Ride times will be assigned at the end of this session following exhibitors competing in the Hunter Dressage classes. They will complete their Jumping class following jump set-up in Cooper Steel Arena. This will not begin before 12pm. Exhibitor scores in Dressage and Jumping classes will be combined for the final ranking in each class. These classes do not count toward the Hunter High Point Awards.
